

Minutes of a meeting of Spreyton Parish Council held in the Village Hall on Tuesday 18th July 2017 at 7.30 pm.

- 1 Apologies:** K Gallop (holiday), P Ridgers (work).
- 2 Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 16th May 2017**
 - 2.1 Having been previously circulated the minutes were agreed and signed.
- 3 Matters arising**
 - 2.2 The consecration of the churchyard extension will now take place on 24th September at 6.00 pm.
- 4 Interests in Agenda items/Dispensations:** None.
- 5 Planning matters**
 - 5.1 The Skywood planning appeal was attended by Cllr Whitaker.
 - 5.2 The site visit after the appeal was attended by Anthony Barker, Bev Cunningham and WDBC.
 - 5.3 The verdict should be received in about 4 weeks.
 - 5.4 A site visit was made re Acorn Farm. The PC's view was neutral but some comments were submitted.
- 6 Highways and footpaths**
 - 6.1 Re-surfacing of the road through the village from the Village Hall to Bowbeer Cross has been completed.
- 7 Community helicopter landing site**
 - 7.1 Cllr Whitaker is attempting to use all of the remaining Section 106 money.
- 8 Church/public toilet**
 - 8.1 It was considered that a flush toilet would not be used enough to justify the cost.
 - 8.2 Therefore it was back to an eco-toilet. In view of location at the back of the churchyard it was considered to be a church matter and not a matter for Parish Council involvement.
- 9 TAP Fund and capital projects**
 - 9.1 The next allocation of TAP funds will be made in November.
 - 9.2 An application to purchase a good strimmer, protective clothing and traffic cones for use by Cllr Collins around the parish will be made.
- 10 Link Committee**
 - 10.1 The free collection of garden waste has now ceased and the new subscription service will commence shortly. The cost is £40 for 14 months.
- 11 Den Brook Community Committee**
 - 11.1 RES were present at the last meeting – the lump sum should be received within 2 weeks.
 - 11.2 An application form is required for any community project. Availability will be notified by advertising after which applications can be made.
 - 11.3 The Committee will decide whether funds will be released.
 - 11.4 Spreyton will have one vote.
 - 11.5 The first applications can be made by the end of August and funds should be released in October.
