2 Minutes of the meeting held on 19th July 2016

2.1 Having been previously circulated the minutes were agreed and signed.

3 Matters arising

3.1 The Section 106 fund applications for the seat on the Village Green and Village Trust projects are proceeding.

3.2 The Council's response to the Local Plan consultation has been submitted and has been acknowledged.

3.3 The North Beer turbine appeal has been rejected.

5 TAP Funds/Capital Projects

5.1 These will be discussed at the next meeting in November.

6 Highways and footpaths

6.1 Darryl Jagger has visited and hopes that the main street will be micro asphalted perhaps next year.

6.2 Bowbeer Lane has not been marked up for patching – perhaps this year.

6.3 Heath Lane has been marked for patching.

6.4 The drains around the the Cullaford area have been cleaned and jetted.

7 Provision of dog/litter bins

7.1 The two bins are now in position and have been screwed down to the concrete slabs.

8 Eco toilet for churchyard

8.1 There are several different types. It was agreed to look at those in situ at Gidleigh church and at The Barn in Manor Road Chagford.

8.2 There is a possibility of connection to the main sewer.

9 Location map/plan of all properties in the village

9.1 Cllr Gallop has got a plan with all the names and will get a plan placed next to the defibrillator.

10 Road safety (speed enforcement)

6.1 Mrs Filor voiced concerns over speeding through the village particularly in the vicinity of Thorn Park, Meadow Rise and Chapel Park entrances. Two cats and one dog have been killed. Cllr Hawking will look into the cost of flashing speeding signs.

11 Grass cutting on the village green

11.1 Cllr Collins has got together a team of six volunteers to do the cutting.

12 Planning matters

12.1 The owners of the Dragdown development were at the meeting. They are using the small shed as temporary accommodation and hope to build permanent structure next year.
